Consultation on Switch Withdrawal Advisory Codes

This paper presents the proposed valid switch withdrawal advisory codes to generators, purchasers and distributors for comment as required by rule 4.1 of Schedule E3 of the Electricity Governance Rules.

Introduction

Purpose of this paper

The purpose of this paper is to present proposed switch withdrawal advisory codes to generators, purchasers and distributors for comment. Once this consultation has occurred, the valid codes will be approved by the Board of the Electricity Commission, and published on the Electricity Commission website.

Background

According to rule 4.1 of Schedule E3 of the Electricity Governance Rules, the Board of the Electricity Commission must determine (in consultation with generators, purchasers and distributors) the valid codes that can be used for withdrawing a switch request, and then publish these codes on its website.

Switch Withdrawal Advisory Codes

Proposed Codes

Rule 4.2.2 of Schedule E3 of the Electricity Governance Rules requires that the retailer withdrawing the switch request must provide a valid withdrawal advisory code. The following table contains the proposed withdrawal advisory codes (which up until now have been detailed in the MARIA Registry User Manual, Version 4.0.02).
