# Electricity Industry (Exemption No. 321 (Transpower NZ Limited)) Exemption Notice

In accordance with section 11 of the Electricity Industry Act 2010 ("Act"), the Electricity Authority ("Authority") gives the following notice.

# Notice

### 1. Title and Commencement

- (1) This notice is the Electricity Industry (Exemption No. 321 Transpower NZ Limited) Exemption Notice 2022.
- (2) This notice comes into force on the day after the date it is notified in the New Zealand Gazette.

### 2. Exemption

- (1) Transpower NZ Limited ("Transpower") is exempted from the complying with the obligations in clauses 10.29B(2) and 10.29C(2) of the Electricity Industry Participation Code 2010 ("Code") that a grid owner may only disconnect or electrically disconnect a point of connection to the grid (that it owns or operates) in specific circumstances.
- (2) This exemption applies only to Transpower.

#### 3. Term

This exemption expires on the earlier of:

- a. the close of **31 May 2025**; or
- b. the date on which either clause 10.29B(2) or 10.29C(2) of the Code are amended by Gazette notice.

## 4. Reasons for Granting the Exemption

The reasons for granting this exemption are:

- a. the exemption will enable the grid owner to process electrical connections and disconnections in an efficient manner;
- b. the exemption will provide time to examine a potential issue in the Code and, if necessary, implement changes; and
- c. granting the requested exemption meets the requirements in section 11(2) of the Act.
