We understand that we have missed the deadline for submissions on the Omnibus three proposed code amendments. Nevertheless, we wanted to share our feedback regarding the 'Expanding distributed generation information in the registry' for your consideration.

We are supportive of the additional information being captured to identify the type of distributed generation (DG) connected. However, our preference is that this new information does not interfere with existing formats used by parties in their day-to-day operations, or that there is an option for parties to select whether they wish to receive the new information through their registry file transfer settings. This flexibility would help avoid imposing unnecessary change costs on all parties and mitigate impacts on existing systems and processes.
