For example a LIST file request named “myRequestForICPData.txt” would have a response file of “LISequestForICPData.txt”. the file naming convention assists with matching input file with their response.</p> <p>Depending on the request file, and if the request file is less than the standard response name the file name can cause an invalid file name to be generated</p>	Complete
ER-1393	31/07/2024	<p>When setting up third party providers as participants in the Registry the Help desk must manually create a supervisor logon to then perform additional administrative tasks using that logon – which they then delete.</p> <p>To save time a supervisor is automatically created as part of the participant creation process (which brings it into line with how other participant roles are currently handled)</p>	Complete
