I agree with giving consumers more options and that flexible distributed generation can reduce future costs.

However, I do not support principles-based rebates for distributors paying a rebate when consumers supply electricity at peak times. Relating to initiative 2A

Instead, I propose distributors pay consumption-linked injection tariffs symmetrically for all consumers. Relating to initiative 2A

I support a new requirement for electricity retailers to pay fair prices to consumers who sell power, extending into dry years and periods of limited supply, reflecting the value of this electricity at all times. Relating to initiative 2C
