Your request

Thank you for your request, received on 21 May 2025, under the Official Information Act 1982 (Act) for the following information:

"I request a list of all currently active consultants and contractors to the Electricity Authority with a contract length of more than three months and/or a contract value above \$25k."

Our response

Where possible, the Electricity Authority Te Mana Hiko (Authority) uses existing employees for all our work. However, some of the work we do as the electricity regulator is highly specialised, and we operate in a dynamic and rapidly evolving sector. Accordingly, there are times we need outside expertise or additional resource to supplement employee numbers for a short time. In these situations, we engage consultants, contractors or professional services firms to enable us to deliver on our priorities.

In 2023/24, we introduced new procedures for engaging consultants and contractors to align with Government guidelines and make sure we are using these resources efficiently. This included recruiting additional employees to help reduce the need for external consultants, which enabled us to be more proactive and responsive when managing issues and unexpected events.

A table of all active consultants and contractors to the Authority (as at 6 June 2025) with a contract length of more than three months and/or a contract value above \$25K is set out in **Appendix One**. Please note that there are no contracts longer the 3 months that have a contract value below \$25K.

The information we've provided distinguishes between contractors and consultants.

- **Contractor definition**: An individual who is hired via a third party to provide temporary specialist skills or perform duties that would normally be provided by an existing staff member, either in their normal day-to-day duties, or on a project.
- Consultant definition: A company or an individual where service provision is linked to a
 defined outcome, typically with remuneration linked to agreed milestones, or deliverables.
 The Authority's functions require significant use of consultants as they have specialist and
 technical knowledge that is not economic to employ on a full-time basis.

For contractors, we have provided details of the recruitment agency or company but withheld individual names under section 9(2)(a) of the Act, to protect the privacy of natural persons.

I am satisfied, under section 9(1) of the Act, that there is no overriding public interest in releasing this information.

You have the right to seek an investigation and review by the Ombudsman of this decision. Information about how to make a complaint is available at www.ombudsman.parliament.nz or freephone 0800 802 602.
