


Electricity Industry Participation Code Amendment (Broadening Definitions of Generating Unit and Intermittent Generating Station) 2020

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Amendment

- Title**
This is the Electricity Industry Participation Code Amendment (Broadening Definitions of Generating Unit and Intermittent Generating Station) 2020.
- Commencement**
This amendment comes into force on 20 March 2020.
- Code amended**
This amendment amends the Electricity Industry Participation Code 2010.

4 Clause 1.1 amended (Interpretation)

- (1) In clause 1.1(1), definition of **bona fide physical reason**, in paragraph (ba)(i), replace “wind” with “variable resource”.
- (2) In clause 1.1(1), replace the definition of **generating unit** with:
“**generating unit** means all equipment functioning together as a single entity to produce electricity”.
- (3) In clause 1.1(1), replace the definition of **intermittent generating station** with:
“**intermittent generating station** means a **generating station** that relies on a variable resource that is not stored”.
- (4) In clause 1.1(1), definition of **synchronised**, replace “machine” with “**generating unit**” in each place.

5 Clause 13.18A amended (Intermittent generators to submit revised forecast of generation potential every trading period in last 2 hours)

In clause 13.18A(3), replace “wind (or other resource)” with “variable resource”.

Explanatory Note

This note is not part of the amendment, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This amendment to the Electricity Industry Participation Code 2010 (Code) comes into force on 20 March 2020.

The amendment makes changes to Part 1 and Part 13 of the Code to allow new generating technologies to participate in the electricity spot market and ancillary service markets regulated by the Code.
